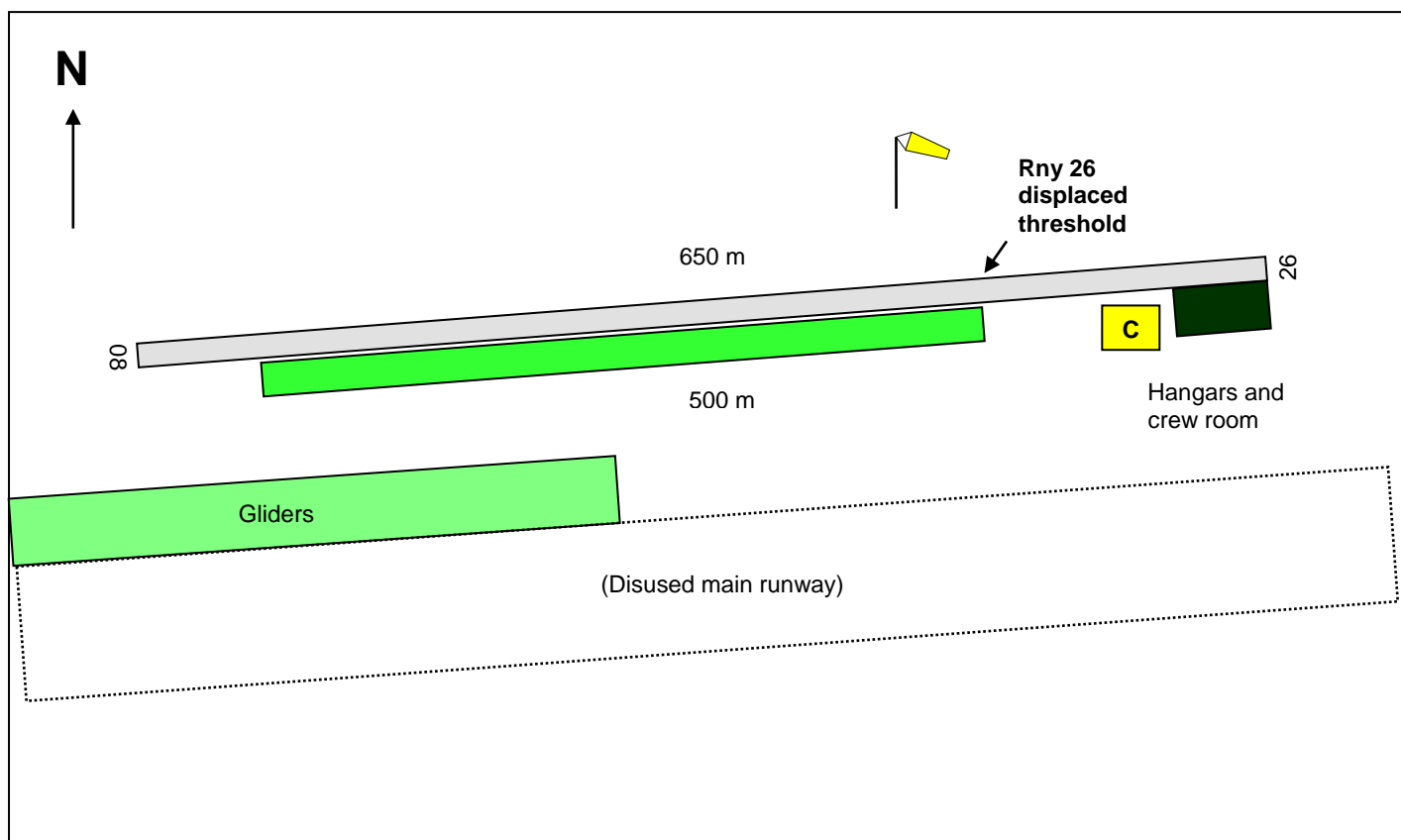

Remarks: Strubby (north) is located on the northern side of the old RAF Strubby Airfield and is operated by Strubby Aviation Club. Visiting aircraft are welcome at pilot's own risk. PPR is not required. Circuit height is 1000' QFE. No overhead joins due to gliders – see Warnings below. No aircraft above 5700 MTOW and no circuit training or touch and goes by visiting aircraft due to planning restrictions. Please avoid overflying all nearby villages.

Warnings: Beware of gliders operating to the south. No overhead joins. Join from the North and use either 26 RH or 08 LH.

Wind farm, turbine height 300' amsl, 2.0 nm from threshold Rwy 26. Hangars/trees close to Rwy 26 threshold. Hedge to west of windsock can cause turbulence on approach to Rwy 26.

Facilities: Snacks and toilets available in crew room accessible at all times to visiting crews. Camping by arrangement.
